Keys to a College Inspired Culture:

✓ Focus on Growth

- Purposeful programming is the norm when all classes are new, novel, and complex.
- Learning is the ultimate goal of each class.
- Increase engagement by providing an avenue for residents to share their skills, talents, and experiences.

✓ An Inclusive Spirit

- An opportunity to bring residents from across the campus together to learn
- Unites team members and residents in planning and experiencing learning together
- Teach classes across the levels of living.
- Small groups facilitate richer social connection.
- Include the greater community! Connect with universities, churches, NORCs, charitable organizations, etc.

✓ Structure

- Tracking engagement is built into the college model through course credits.
- Semesters/Trimesters provide an opportunity to dig deeper into topics or themes.
- Keep momentum going with weekly committee meetings, etc.
- Consider the budget necessary to support your college.

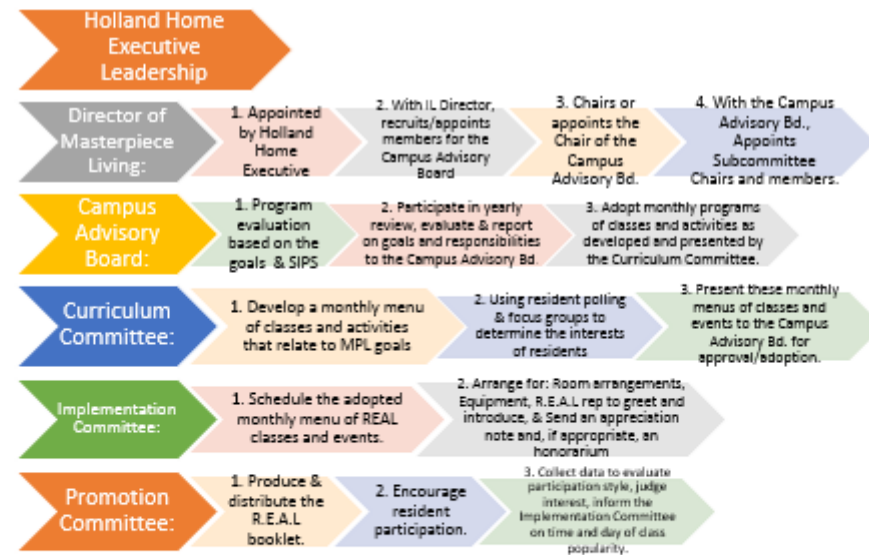


A Guide to Get Your College Started!
