



2019 CSA Qualification Checklist

Thank you for your interest in the Centers for Successful Aging designation. Use the following checklist to determine if your organization meets the initial eligibility criteria for this application period. If your organization does not meet these criteria, use the criteria as your strategic plan to prepare to apply during a future application period.

The link for the Qualification Checklist will be emailed on Friday, July 12, 2019. **Please submit your answers by midnight, Mountain Time on Friday, August 9, 2019.**

Centers for Successful Aging can demonstrate **sustained** successful aging **cultural enhancements**. Sustained enhancements are policies, procedures and operations related to successful aging which are woven into the fabric of the organization. The CSA application proves that the initiative is systematic rather than person dependent.

Checklist (All items on this checklist must be completed to be eligible for application):

- Review completion requirements:
 - A minimum of 45% Review completion (*calculated by Partnership Specialist*)
 - Lifestyle Review and Mobility Review
 - Independent Living, Assisted Living and all other applicable levels of living
 - Includes each of the past two Review Campaigns

Note: 50% Review completion is needed by the CSA Application deadline **September 27, 2019.**

- The 2019 CSA Criteria & Measures have been reviewed and a minimum of 80%+ are met.
- The community is 18 months post-launch/debut as of **August 1, 2019.**
- There are a minimum of two annual data points with interventions based on data in place.
- An active Champion Team is in place, which including ED at all meetings.
 - Refer to Champion Team Formula and to "Active Champion Team" criteria description.
- Successful Aging/Masterpiece Living (MPL) is incorporated into the community's strategic plan.
- The community has integrated successful aging/MPL in Independent and Assisted Living (if applicable).
- The Executive Director and at least one Champion Team member have completed Foundational Training in the last 4 years (**August 1, 2015 through August 1, 2019**).
- A minimum of 90% of all team members were trained initially and are trained on an ongoing basis.
- Team members and residents share their passions and skills with the community in a meaningful way through programming or other contributions.
- Multiple Champion Team Members and the Executive Director have reviewed the criteria and have developed a team approach for completing the application.
